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DID YOU KNOW

We all know by now that Joe Biden is President Elect of the United States, even though Alabama voted overwhelmingly against him. But do you know what your votes in the other November 3rd election areas meant?

Amendment 1 amended the Alabama Constitution to state that "only a citizen of the United States," rather than "every citizen of the United States," who is 18 years old or older has the right to vote in Alabama. Only vs Every—what does it mean to you?



What did Amendment 4 do?

This measure authorized the Alabama state legislature—during the 2022 regular state legislative session—to recompile the Alabama Constitution and provide for its ratification.

According to the text of the proposed amendment, authorized changes to the constitution were designed to include:

- arranging it in proper articles, parts, and sections;
- removing all racist language;
- deleting duplicative and repealed provisions;
- consolidating provisions regarding economic development; and
