




The Month of DHUL QADAH Eleventh Month of the Islamic (Hijri) Calendar

HAJJ 2022 UPDATES Brief Answers to Frequently Asked Hajj Questions

What is the latest information on Hajj 2022?

The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) will be allowing one million international and domestic pilgrims to attend Hajj this year. Due to an increase in cost of services and taxes by the KSA, an increment is expected in the Hajj expenses.

What is the Hajj season 2022? The dates for Hajj 1443H/2022 are around the 7 to 12 of July. Hajj begins on the 8th day of Dhul Hijjah (the twelfth and final month of the Islamic calendar) and ends by the 13th day. The date of Hajj is about eleven days earlier each year because the Islamic calendar is eleven days shorter than the calendar used in the western world.

Can I wear my usual clothes during Hajj?

For the Hajj rites you will be in Ihram. For males the dress is basically two pieces of unsewn




AGE DISTRIBUTION AMONG US MUSLIMS



white cloth. When not performing Hajj rites, males can wear their usual modest clothing. Females can wear usual modest clothing, although many prefer to wear white. Keep in mind the saying "when in Rome"; meaning be sure your definition of modest meets your host country's standards.



Can I enter the Kaaba during Hajj? The Kaaba is kept closed during the Hajj because of the overwhelming number of people But, those who visit the Kaaba during other times of the year are sometimes allowed to go inside. It's quite beautiful. The walls are white marble on the lower half and green cloth on the upper half.

Is there an age limit for Hajj? As with any journey, it is important to make sure you are fit, spiritually, physically, and mentally. This is even more important for Hajj: The Journey of a Lifetime. Check with your health provider and Hajj provider for details regarding specifics due to age.
