Here are five things you need to know about the Islamic New Year and its significance:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The Hijri calendar starts from the month of Muharram, which is also known as the month of Allah. And so, this is considered as an auspicious period. 2. Muslims believe that Allah wishes that people should not commit sins during the sacred month of Muharram. Many Muslim scholars believe that if one commits sin during this holy month then their sin shall be considered greater and so their punishment will also be more severe as compared to if it was committed at any other time of the year. And so, one should be careful as to not commit any wrong deeds during the sacred month of Allah. 3. After the month of Ramadan, Muharram or the month of Allah

August 24, 2021 is election day in the city of Mobile. If, in the future, you are not satisfied with those running, here's how you can qualify.

Qualifications to Run

For Mayor

Registered voter of the city of Mobile
Resident of city for at least 90 days before the election date
At least 25 years of age
Qualifying fee: \$500

For City Council

Registered voter of the city of Mobile and of the particular council district
Resident of city for at least one year before the election date
Resident of district for at least 90 days before election date
At least 21 years of age
Qualifying fee: \$125

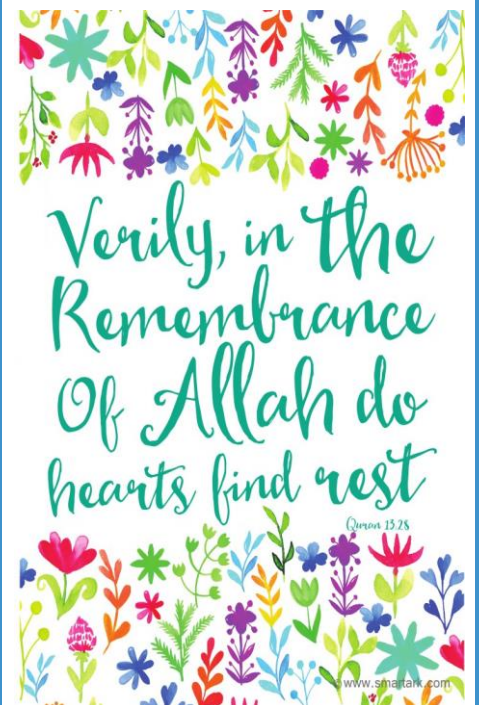


is also considered as a great period for fasting.

4. This holy month also has a great day of the year for fasting, called the Day of Ashura which is marked on the 10th day of Muharram. According to Prophet Muhammad fasting on the Day of Ashura removes all the sins of the previous year. And so, many Muslim followers choose to fast on the ninth and tenth days of this month.

5. The Islamic years are generally symbolized as the letter "H" for the Hijrah calendar, or "AH" which is the Latin term for "in the year of the Hijrah" or Anno Hegirae. Muslims can observe and celebrate their new year by visiting the mosque, praying to Allah for everyone's well-being and by spending time with their family and near and dear ones.
