Al Hijrah or the Prophet's Emigration

Much persecution of Muslims by the people of Mecca, including members of the Quraysh, a prominent community in Mecca, led the Prophet to encourage migration to Abyssinia. Even though the Christian ruler was kind to those who migrated, this proved not to be enough for many of those who migrated to Abyssinia. Muslims also left Mecca and went in small groups to Yathrib (Madinah). Some stayed, others were sent back. When the command of ALLAH came for the Prophet to emigrate from Mecca to Madinah (Yathrib), Muhammad asked Abu Bakr to accompany him. Haykal describes: "During Muhammad's long and exhaustive trip, the news reached his companions in Yathrib that he had emigrated to join them.

This causes them to miss seeing all the continuous help that G-D provides to them each second of their life such as protecting them while they are asleep. Comparing the indigenous African American community to other ethnic communities, we are in a worse condition due to the psychological effects of slavery that we have been carrying for generations.
